

5 DAY HEAT - WORKING IN EXTREMELY VOLATILE, HIGH-RISK AREAS

Our most advanced HEAT course is for those working in areas destabilised by war, imminent terrorism threat and civil unrest - where the threat level is categorised as extremely high.

We guide learners through a rigorous 5-day programme, where training starts the minute participants arrive at our private rural training centre.

Through planning, risk assessment, navigation and SOPs learners work their way through a series of scenarios designed to develop rational, decisive decision making and build self-confidence. This training improves mission efficiency and operational planning to increase team safety.

Learners will gain skills to mitigate risk in order to operate efficiently and safely, ensuring the highest level of security for themselves and their team whilst deployed to challenging environments and in the face of adverse situations.

All of our courses are based on the UN model and ENTRI curriculum.

3-DAY HEFAT - HOSTILE ENVIRONMENT FIRST AID TRAINING - TRAVEL TO MEDIUM & HIGH RISK AREAS

This course focuses on travel safety, situational awareness, threat management and modules specific to travel in areas of medium to high risk areas. Our HEFAT also includes a one-day QA First Aid certification is taken on the last day of training – with a focus on field trauma and improvisation.

Through immersive scenario training learners practice how to react when faced with distressing and stressful situations. Where do you position yourself under fire if you are exiting a vehicle? How do you deal with illegal checkpoints? What risk assessments and SOPs can you and your team put in place to improve your safety?

We slow down situations by replaying training scenarios to develop more advanced comping mechanisms and decision making in stressed simulations.

We advise on the most appropriate medical kit and protective equipment to be taken on deployment. Also how to identify medical risks and access to treatment whilst deployed.

2 DAY - ELEMENTARY HEAT - FOR TRAVEL TO MEDIUM TO HIGH-RISK AREAS.

Travelling abroad on a mission can be exciting, however, complex environments can be challenging and de-stabilising. In order for individuals and teams to work more efficiently comprehensive training is essential for mitigating risk.

This 2-day, 20 hour course follows the same modules as our HEFAT without the one day First Aid. This is an intense schedule - but we give learners time for self reflection and experience sharing.

We strongly suggest that a robust First Aid certificate – with a focus on trauma – is obtained by all personnel prior to deployment.

Through immersive scenario training learners practice how to react when faced with distressing and stressful situations. Where do you position yourself under fire if you are exiting a vehicle? How do you deal with illegal checkpoints? What risk assessments and SOPs can you and your team put in place prior to departure to improve your safety? We slow down situations by replaying training scenarios to develop more advanced comping mechanisms and decision making in stressed simulations.

This one day refresher course revisits the modules of the HEAT course the learner took with us or another HEAT company.

The refresher course but can be taught online if require by the organisation due to location of personnel. However, we recommend that the course is taught face-to-face.

By keeping knowledge up to date and training contemporary, employers can ensure that their corporate duty of care is fulfilled. Refresher training reinforces best practice and and refreshes memory keeping individuals and teams informed and safety briefed whilst on mission.

TRAVEL SAFETY AWARENESS TRAINING – FOR THOSE WORKING OR TRAVELLING IN LOW TO MEDIUM RISK AREAS – 2 DAY COURSE

Travel Safety Awareness Training is part of our HEAT suite, it has elements of Hostile Environment Awareness Training, however the training is levelled at low to medium risk environments and not places of high-risk deployment.

This course suits those deployed to countries with complex challenges but classed as low to medium risk.

If you are being deployed or travelling in a country deemed as unsafe by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, then this course is the right course for you.

Length of course can vary from organisation depending on prior experience and requirements. First Aid can be added on to the course if required.

This course covers, gender awareness, cultural awareness, travel safety, situational awareness and much more.

Learner suitability

Learners must have a good grasp of English and be able to participate in the programme that is taught fully in the English language

Learners must be over the age of 18 to take this course

Prior to course enrolment learners must complete a health and fitness questionnaire and declare any illness be it physical or mental, that could effect their ability to complete the course.

HEAT training can be psychologically and physically demanding. A questionnaire will be sent out prior to enrolment for health and safety purposes.

Soteria Risk Training will assess learner suitability for this course. Learners will be asked to complete an application and questionnaire before attendance.
